CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Wicomico County – Alcoholic Beverages – Youth and Civic Center License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Wicomico County a Class B Youth and Civic Center
4 license; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to a
5 designee of the County Executive of Wicomico County for use by a certain youth and
6 civic center; during the term of the license, requiring a certain youth and civic center
7 to maintain a kitchen, dining space, and meeting space; authorizing a holder of the
8 license to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption to individuals
9 attending a youth and civic center event; specifying the hours that the license
10 privilege may be exercised; authorizing the license holder to authorize a vendor to
11 sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption under a certain license;
12 authorizing the license holder to contract to receive a proportion of the revenue
13 derived from a vendor's sale of alcoholic beverages; specifying an annual license fee;
14 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Wicomico County.

2 (As enacted by Chapter ____ (S.B. 724) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2016)

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

6 32–102.

7 This title applies only in Wicomico County.

8 **32–1005.**

9 **(A) THERE IS A CLASS B YOUTH AND CIVIC CENTER LICENSE.**

10 **(B) (1) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A LICENSE TO A DESIGNEE OF THE**
11 **COUNTY EXECUTIVE FOR USE AT THE WICOMICO YOUTH AND CIVIC CENTER.**

12 **(2) DURING THE TERM OF THE LICENSE, THE WICOMICO YOUTH AND**
13 **CIVIC CENTER SHALL MAINTAIN:**

14 **(I) A KITCHEN;**

15 **(II) DINING SPACE; AND**

16 **(III) MEETING SPACE.**

17 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE,**
18 **AND LIQUOR FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION TO INDIVIDUALS ATTENDING A**
19 **YOUTH AND CIVIC CENTER EVENT.**

20 **(D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR DURING THE**
21 **HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR A CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE**
22 **UNDER § 32–2005 OF THIS TITLE.**

23 **(E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY:**

24 **(1) AUTHORIZE A VENDOR TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR**
25 **ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION UNDER THE LICENSE THAT THE MANAGER OF THE**
26 **YOUTH AND CIVIC CENTER IS ISSUED; AND**

27 **(2) CONTRACT TO RECEIVE PART OF THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM**
28 **THE VENDOR’S SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

1 **(F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.**

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
3 1, 2016.
