(Senate Bill 1033)

AN ACT concerning

**Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2015 – Worcester County –
Delmarva Discovery Center and Museum**

FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2015 to add a grantee to certain grants; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2015.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Chapter 495 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2015
Section 1(3) Item ZA02(BC) and Item ZA03(BQ)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

That:

(BC) Delmarva Discovery Center and Museum. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Pocomoke **AND THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DELMARVA DISCOVERY CENTER & MUSEUM, INC.** for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Delmarva Discovery Center and Museum, located in Worcester County. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Worcester County)..... 100,000

ZA03 SENATE INITIATIVES
(Statewide)

(BQ) Delmarva Discovery Center and Museum. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$75,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Pocomoke **AND**

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DELMARVA DISCOVERY CENTER & MUSEUM, INC. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Delmarva Discovery Center and Museum, located in Worcester County. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act (Worcester County)..... 75,000

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
