10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)				
<p>The Baltimore County Monument Commission, Inc. was formed to oversee the fundraising, design, construction, dedication and ongoing maintenance of a memorial to honor all the men and women who served in Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. It is a recognized 501(c)3 organization. The Commission was formed after a resolution for the creation of a memorial was introduced to the Baltimore County Council in 2011 by Fifth District Baltimore County Councilman David Marks. The Council passed the resolution through a unanimous vote. The Commission's members include veterans of the Iraqi and Afghanistan conflicts as well as veterans of the Vietnam War, representatives of veterans organizations, representatives of civic organizations, prominent attorneys and several elected officials on the local, state and federal level.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The project includes the design, construction, and maintenance of this Memorial. It also includes the raising of the necessary funds to meet all expenses for this project as well as a ceremony to dedicate the Memorial when completed. The Desert Storm, OEF, OIF Memorial will honor all those men and women who served in these conflicts. The Memorial will reside on the grounds of the Baltimore County Courthouse. It will be constructed in granite and will have the names of those who gave the ultimate sacrifice etched into the granite. It will be co-located with the Vietnam Memorial, dedicated in 1996, to create a Memorial Garden. The site will include the Memorial itself, decorative boulders, reflection bench, lighting, interpretive signage and landscaping.
