10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Religious Coalition for Emergency Human Needs (The Religious Coalition) is Maryland's second-largest County-wide interfaith agency providing emergency assistance to homeless and working poor individuals and families in Frederick County, MD. Founded in 1981 by an interdenominational group of leaders, our human needs support includes emergency shelter for homeless individuals and families, homelessness prevention assistance, medical prescription cost assistance, dental cost assistance, and food assistance. The Religious Coalition is Frederick County's "point of entry" for clients seeking emergency support. Clients are referred to us by word-of-mouth and by our 100+ community partners.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Religious Coalition's Emergency Family Services Shelter is Frederick County's only 24/7 shelter for homeless families with children. Prior to 2014, there was no emergency shelter or support services available to homeless families in Frederick County. Therefore, this serious and growing need was addressed by The Religious Coalition and local houses of worship. In September 2014 the Emergency Family Services Shelter opened. Homeless families receive overnight shelter at local houses of worship and during the day, receive case management support to help them find affordable housing and employment. The purpose of this project is to renovate a former church parsonage (located at 200 West All Saints' St., in downtown Frederick) near The Religious Coalition's headquarters. The building will serve the Emergency Family Services Shelter as the location for daytime case management and support to homeless families.
