#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and West" and substitute "<u>West,</u> <u>Pendergrass, Bromwell, Angel, Barron, Cullison, Hayes, Hill, Kelly, Krebs, McDonough,</u> <u>Metzgar, Miele, Morales, Morgan, Pena-Melnyk, Platt, Rosenberg, Saab, Sample-Hughes, Szeliga, and K. Young</u>"; strike beginning with "renaming" in line 3 down through "Advisor;" in line 5; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 14 down through "date;" in line 16 and substitute "<u>requiring the Department of Transportation, in</u> <u>consultation with a certain association, to study a certain issue and report to certain</u> <u>committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date;</u>"; strike lines 18 through 22, inclusive; and after line 27, insert:

"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u> <u>Article – State Finance and Procurement</u>

<u>Section 13-221 and 15-218</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2015 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement)".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 4 on page 2 through line 10 on page 4, inclusive.

On page 7, strike in their entirety lines 14 through 20, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That on or before December 1, 2017, the Department of Transportation, in consultation with the Maryland-Delaware-District of Columbia Press Association, shall:
