### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "<u>Gun-Free</u>" and substitute "<u>Weapon-Free</u>"; in line 6, strike "<u>or possessing</u>"; in line 7, after the first "<u>on</u>" insert "<u>public</u>"; strike beginning with the first "<u>on</u>" in line 9 down through "<u>dispositions</u>" in line 20 and substitute "<u>; requiring a public institution of higher education to post certain signs at certain locations</u>"; strike beginning with "<u>the</u>" in line 21 down through "<u>procedures</u>" in line 22 and substitute "<u>into their bylaws, policies, and procedures, the current weapons practice on their campuses</u>"; and in line 23, strike "on the property of" and substitute "<u>at</u>".

On page 2, in line 7, strike "Criminal Law" and substitute "<u>Education</u>"; in line 8, strike "4-102.1" and substitute "<u>15-121</u>"; and in line 10, strike "(2012" and substitute "(2014".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 7, after the semicolon insert "<u>OR</u>"; strike beginning with "<u>THE</u>" in line 8 down through "<u>(9)</u>" in line 15; and in lines 23 and 26, in each instance, strike "<u>SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF</u>".

On pages 4 through 8, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 28 on page 4 through line 8 on page 8, inclusive, and substitute:
