On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in the sponsor line, strike "and Tarlau" and substitute "<u>Tarlau, Bromwell, Cullison, Hayes, Hill, Kipke,</u> <u>Krebs, McDonough, Metzgar, Miele, Morales, Morgan, Pendergrass, Platt, Rosenberg,</u> <u>Saab, Sample-Hughes, Szeliga, West, and K. Young</u>"; in lines 2 and 3, strike "Preauthorization for Drug Products to Treat Substance Use Disorders" and substitute "<u>Prior Authorization for Drug Products to Treat an Opioid Use Disorder</u>"; in line 6, after "products" insert "<u>under certain circumstances</u>"; in lines 6 and 7, strike "providing for a delayed effective date" and substitute "<u>making this Act an emergency measure</u>"; and in line 8, strike "substance use disorders" and substitute "<u>opioid use disorders</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 20, after "FOR" insert "<u>SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER</u> BENEFITS OR".

On page 2, in line 2, after "FOR" insert "<u>SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER BENEFITS</u> <u>OR</u>"; in line 5, after "FOR" insert "<u>SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER BENEFITS UNDER THE</u> <u>MEDICAL BENEFIT OR FOR</u>"; in line 9, after "FOR" insert "<u>A PRESCRIPTION DRUG</u>:

(1) WHEN USED FOR TREATMENT OF AN OPIOID USE DISORDER;

AND

(2) <u>THAT CONTAINS</u>";

and in line 10, strike "INJECTABLE".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 13, strike "January 1, 2018" and substitute "<u>the effective date</u> <u>of this Act</u>"; in lines 14 and 15, strike "shall take effect January 1, 2018" and substitute "<u>is an emergency measure</u>, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public <u>health or safety</u>, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take <u>effect from the date it is enacted.</u>".
