AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1178 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Incorrect Enrollments" and substitute "<u>Membership</u> <u>- Study</u>"; and strike beginning with "that" in line 3 down through "enrollments" in line 13 and substitute "<u>the State Retirement Agency and the Department of Legislative</u> <u>Services to conduct a certain study regarding membership in the Employees' Pension</u> <u>System for certain individuals who are employed in positions for which the budgeted</u> <u>hours are less than a certain number of hours per fiscal year; requiring the study to</u> <u>include certain elements; requiring the State Retirement Agency and the Department</u> <u>of Legislative Services to report their findings and recommendations to the Joint</u> <u>Committee on Pensions on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this</u> <u>Act; and generally relating to a study regarding the membership of certain individuals</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 16 on page 1 through line 15 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

"(a) <u>The State Retirement Agency and the Department of Legislative Services</u> <u>shall:</u>

(1) <u>conduct a study regarding membership in the Employees' Pension</u> System for individuals who are employed in a position for which the budgeted hours per fiscal year are less than 500 hours, including:

(i) <u>the individuals who are required to join the Employees</u> <u>Pension System under current law as a condition of employment;</u>

(ii) the individuals who have optional membership in the Employees' Pension System under current law; and

(Over)

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(iii) the impact of Chapter 182 of the Acts of 2015 on the enrollment of individuals in the Employees' Pension System; and

(2) <u>make recommendations regarding suggested statutory changes, if</u> <u>necessary, relating to membership in the Employees' Pension System for individuals</u> <u>who are employed in a position for which the budgeted hours per fiscal year are less</u> <u>than 500 hours.</u>

(b) On or before December 1, 2017, the State Retirement Agency and the Department of Legislative Services shall report their findings and recommendations to the Joint Committee on Pensions.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 17, strike "and 6 months"; and in line 18, strike "December 31" and substitute "<u>June 30</u>".
