A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Circuit Courts – Fee for Special Admission of Out-of-State Attorney –**
3 **Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment Program**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of the fee that the State Court Administrator is
5 required to assess for the special admission of an out-of-state attorney; increasing
6 the portion of the fee that is required to be paid to the Janet L. Hoffman Loan
7 Assistance Repayment Program; and generally relating to funding for the
8 Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment Program.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

1 (a) (1) (i) The State Court Administrator shall determine the amount of all
2 court costs and charges for the circuit courts of the counties with the approval of the Board
3 of Public Works.

4 (ii) The fees and charges shall be uniform throughout the State.

5 (2) The Comptroller of the State shall require clerks of court to collect all
6 fees required to be collected by law.

7 (f) The State Court Administrator shall:

8 (1) Assess a [~~\$100~~] **\$250** fee for the special admission of an out-of-state
9 attorney under § 10-215 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article; and

10 (2) Pay [~~\$75~~] **\$225** of the fee to the Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance
11 Repayment Program established under § 18-1502 of the Education Article.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2017.
