BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 27–102 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2016 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 27–906 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2016 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
