A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Public Schools – Health and Safety – Video Cameras**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners to install
4 and maintain a certain number of video cameras in certain school locations for
5 certain purposes; requiring the board to retain certain video recordings for a certain
6 period of time; requiring the board to adopt certain regulations; providing for the
7 application of this Act; and generally relating to video cameras at Baltimore City
8 Public Schools.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 **7–440.**

18 **(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.**

19 **(B) THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS SHALL:**

20 **(1) INSTALL AND MAINTAIN AT LEAST TWO OPERATIONAL VIDEO**
21 **CAMERAS ON THE EXTERIOR PREMISES OF EACH BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
22 **SITE FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECORDING ILLEGAL ACTIVITY; AND**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(2) PRESERVE THE RECORDINGS MADE BY THE VIDEO CAMERAS FOR**
2 **AT LEAST 6 MONTHS.**

3 **(C) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE**
4 **REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2017.
