## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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#### Article – Insurance

15 (a) A pharmacy benefits manager registration expires on the [anniversary date 16 that occurs on the date 2 years following the date the Commissioner issued the 17 registration,] SECOND SEPTEMBER 30 AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE unless it is renewed 18 as provided under this section.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2017.
