A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Public Schools – Active Assailant Event Training and Drills**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Superintendent of Schools to conduct
4 active assailant event training for school personnel in Baltimore County each school
5 year; requiring the Baltimore County Superintendent to require certain public
6 schools to hold an active assailant event drill a certain number of times each school
7 year; requiring certain training and drills to comply with guidelines established by
8 the Maryland State Police; requiring certain public schools to keep certain records
9 and send a copy of certain records to the Baltimore County Superintendent and the
10 Baltimore County Board of Education on or before a certain date each year; and
11 generally relating to active assailant event training and drills in Baltimore County
12 public schools.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

21 **7–440.**

22 **(A) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS SHALL**
23 **CONDUCT ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT TRAINING FOR SCHOOL PERSONNEL IN**
24 **BALTIMORE COUNTY EACH SCHOOL YEAR.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(B) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL REQUIRE EACH**
2 **BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL TO HOLD AN ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT DRILL**
3 **THREE TIMES EACH SCHOOL YEAR.**

4 **(C) THE ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT TRAINING AND DRILLS REQUIRED**
5 **UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE**
6 **MARYLAND STATE POLICE.**

7 **(D) EACH BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL:**

8 **(1) KEEP RECORDS OF THE ACTIVE ASSAILANT EVENT DRILLS HELD**
9 **IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION; AND**

10 **(2) SEND A COPY OF THE RECORDS TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY**
11 **SUPERINTENDENT AND THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION ON OR**
12 **BEFORE JULY 1 EACH YEAR.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
14 1, 2017.
