BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10–410(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 10-410.(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), (6), (7), (8), [and] (9), AND (10) of this subsection, a person may not hunt any game bird or mammal on Sundays. (2)The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals on Sundays:


