15	(b) (1) Commissioners shall be adult residents of the [counties] COUNTY OR
16	A COUNTY CONTIGUOUS TO THE COUNTY in which they serve, but they need not be
17	lawyers.
18	(2) Each commissioner shall hold office at the pleasure of the Chief Judge
19	of the District Court, and has the powers and duties prescribed by law.
20	(3) Except without additional compensation, unless otherwise fixed by law,
21 22	an employee of the District Court, who is an adult, may be granted, in the same manner, commissioner powers and duties in the county where the employee is employed.
