- (5) the term of the member appointed from legislative district 31 in Anne Arundel County whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2020, shall expire at the end of December 6, 2020, and the member elected from councilmanic district 2 in Anne Arundel County at the general election in November 2020 shall succeed that member and serve for a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2020, until a successor is elected and qualifies;
- 31 (6) the term of the member appointed from legislative district 30 in Anne 32 Arundel County whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2020, shall expire at the end 33 of December 6, 2020, and the member elected from councilmanic district 6 in Anne Arundel 34 County at the general election in November 2020 shall succeed that member and serve for 35 a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2020, until a successor is elected and qualifies;
- 36 (7) the term of the member appointed from legislative district 33 in Anne 37 Arundel County whose term is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2021, shall expire at the end 38 of December 6, 2020, and the member elected from councilmanic district 5 in Anne Arundel

- 1 County at the general election in November 2020 shall succeed that member and serve for
- 2 a term of 4 years beginning on December 7, 2020, until a successor is elected and qualifies;
- 3 and
- 4 (8) the term of the member appointed from the county at large whose term
- 5 is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2019, shall expire at the end of June 30, 2019, and the
- 6 County Executive of Anne Arundel County shall appoint a member to succeed that member
- 7 and serve for a term of 4 years beginning on July 1, 2019, until a successor is elected and
- 8 qualifies.
- 9 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2017.
