1 AN ACT concerning

Criminal Law – Homicide by Motor Vehicle or Vessel While Impaired by a Controlled Dangerous Substance – Penalties

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Criminal Law

15 2-506.

16 (a) A person may not cause the death of another as a result of the person's
17 negligently driving, operating, or controlling a motor vehicle or vessel while the person is
18 impaired by a controlled dangerous substance, as defined in § 5-101 of this article.

19 (b) A violation of this section is homicide by motor vehicle or vessel while impaired
20 by a controlled dangerous substance.

(ii) For the purposes of application of subsequent offender penalties under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, a conviction for a crime committed in another state or federal jurisdiction that, if committed in this State would constitute a violation of this section, § 2-209, § 2-210, § 2-503, § 2-504, § 2-505, or § 3-211 of this article, or § 21-902 of the Transportation Article, shall be considered a violation of this section.

13 (d) This section does not apply to a person who is entitled to use the controlled
14 dangerous substance under the laws of this State.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2017.
