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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Metropolitan Commission – Personnel**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the type of position of certain personnel in the St. Mary's  
4 County Metropolitan Commission; establishing certain personnel positions in the  
5 Commission as contractual positions; establishing that the Director of the  
6 Commission is the immediate supervisor of certain personnel; and generally relating  
7 to personnel in the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County  
10 Section 113–1C.  
11 Article 19 – Public Local Laws of Maryland  
12 (2007 Edition and October 2014 Supplement, as amended)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 19 – St. Mary's County**

16 113–1.

17 C. The Commission shall elect one (1) of its members as Chairman and one (1) of  
18 its members as Vice Chairman, who shall serve in the absence or disability of the  
19 Chairman. The Commission shall appoint, discharge at pleasure and fix the compensation  
20 of a Director, a Secretary, [~~a Treasurer, a Chief Engineer~~] and engineering, legal, clerical

1 and other personnel and help which the Commission deems necessary to carry out the  
 2 provisions of this chapter. The Commission may, **BY CONTRACT**, appoint[, discharge at  
 3 pleasure] and fix the compensation of a General Counsel, **TREASURER OR CHIEF**  
 4 **FINANCIAL OFFICER, CHIEF ENGINEER, AND ANY OTHER DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR.**  
 5 The Director may not serve concurrently as the Director and as General Counsel to the  
 6 Commission. **THE DIRECTOR SHALL BE THE IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR OF THE**  
 7 **GENERAL COUNSEL, TREASURER OR CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER, CHIEF**  
 8 **ENGINEER, AND ANY OTHER DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR.**

9           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 10 October 1, 2017.
