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1 AN ACT concerning

## Task Force on Organized Retail Crime Rings

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force on Organized Retail Crime Rings; 4 providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a 5 member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the 6 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make 7 recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its 8 findings and recommendations to certain committees of the General Assembly on or 9 before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating 10 to the Task Force on Organized Retail Crime Rings.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That:

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- (a) There is a Task Force on Organized Retail Crime Rings.
- 14 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 15 (1) a member of the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee, appointed by 16 the President of the Senate;
- 17 (2) a member of the House Judiciary Committee, appointed by the Speaker 18 of the House:

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| (h) On or before October 1, 2018, the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House Judiciary Committee.   |
| SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2017. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2018, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. |
