1 AN ACT concerning

Pricing and Selection Committee for Blind Industries and Services of Maryland and the Employment Works Program – Staff

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of General Services to provide staff for the

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article State Finance and Procurement
- 17 14–106.

(a) In this section, "Committee" means the Pricing and Selection Committee for
 Blind Industries and Services of Maryland and the Employment Works Program.

- 20 (b) There is a Pricing and Selection Committee for Blind Industries and Services 21 of Maryland and the Employment Works Program.
- 22 (c) The Committee consists of the following 5 members:
- 23 (1) the Secretary of Transportation or a designee;



(2)1 the Secretary of General Services or a designee; $\mathbf{2}$ (3)the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services or a designee; 3 the Assistant Secretary for Vocational Rehabilitation within the State (4)Department of Education or a designee; and 4 the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation or a designee. $\mathbf{5}$ (5)A member of the Committee: 6 (d) 7 (1)may not receive compensation; but 8 (2)is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 9 Travel Regulations as provided in the State budget. 10THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR **(E)** 11 THE COMMITTEE. 12[(e)] **(F)** The Committee shall: 13 ensure that supplies and services provided by Blind Industries and (1)Services of Maryland or a community service provider create work opportunities for 14individuals who have a mental or physical disability, including blindness, for which Blind 15Industries and Services of Maryland or the community service provider was established to 16 17assist: 18 (2)set the prices of supplies and services that Blind Industries and 19 Services of Maryland provides to reflect the fair market prices for the supplies and services; 20establish procedures to govern procurement of supplies and services (3)21from community service providers and individual with disability owned businesses; 22(4)from the State procurement list, choose appropriate supplies and 23services for community service providers and individual with disability owned businesses 24to offer for procurement; 25provide that the State procure those supplies and services from a (5)26community service provider or an individual with disability owned business; 27if supplies or services are not available for procurement from a unit of (6)28the State government, determine whether supplies or services are available from a 29community service provider or an individual with disability owned business; 30 determine the fair market price of supplies and services that (7)community service providers and individual with disability owned businesses provide; 31

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1 (8) in accordance with market conditions, adjust prices for the supplies and 2 services that community service providers and individual with disability owned businesses 3 provide; and

4 (9) at the request of a community service provider or an individual with 5 disability owned business, review and, if appropriate, change the price of a supply or 6 service.

7 [(f)] (G) In addition to the duties specified under subsection [(e)](F) of this 8 section, the Committee shall:

9 (1) establish and periodically review eligibility policies or guidelines for 10 participating community service providers and individual with disability owned 11 businesses;

12 (2) maintain a current list of community service providers and individual 13 with disability owned businesses;

14 (3) periodically review and revise its list of community service providers 15 and individual with disability owned businesses; and

16 (4) send any revised list to the Secretary of General Services who shall 17 make the list available to each person responsible for buying supplies or services for the 18 State or a State aided or controlled entity.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June20 1, 2017.
