Vehicle Laws – HOV Lanes – Tow Trucks

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person may not drive a vehicle in an HOV lane unless authorized by a traffic control device.

(c) (1) The following vehicles may be driven in an HOV lane at all times regardless of the number of passengers in or on the vehicle:

10 (i) A bus;

11 (ii) A motorcycle; [and]

12 (iii) A plug-in electric drive vehicle displaying a valid permit issued
13 under § 25–108 of this article; AND

14 (IV) A TOW TRUCK THAT IS PROPERLY REGISTERED IN
15 ACCORDANCE WITH § 13-920 OF THIS ARTICLE AND IS USING ANY VISUAL SIGNAL
16 THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 22-218 OF THIS ARTICLE WHILE
17 RESPONDING TO A CALL FOR SERVICE IF AN APPROPRIATE LAW ENFORCEMENT
18 AGENCY HAS AUTHORIZED THE TOW TRUCK OPERATOR TO USE HOV LANES.

(2) A qualified hybrid vehicle displaying a valid permit issued under § 25–108 of this article may be driven in the portion of U.S. Route 50 designated as an HOV lane, between Interstate 95/Interstate 495 and U.S. Route 301, at all times regardless of the number of passengers in or on the vehicle.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 October 1, 2017.
