A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Regulation – Motor Fuel Retail Service Station – Attendant Required**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a retail service station to have an attendant available to
4 process certain payments during the retail service station's hours of operation; and
5 generally relating to an attendant required at a motor fuel retail service station.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Business Regulation**

14 **10–325.**

15 **EACH RETAIL SERVICE STATION SHALL HAVE AN ATTENDANT AVAILABLE TO**
16 **PROCESS CASH PAYMENTS FROM CUSTOMERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOTOR FUEL**
17 **DURING THE RETAIL SERVICE STATION'S HOURS OF OPERATION.**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2017.
