A BILL ENTITLED

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Children Exempt From Public School Attendance – Participation in Public High School Clubs and Activities

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain local school systems to allow a certain child who is 5 exempt from public school attendance to participate in certain clubs and activities 6 beginning on a certain date; requiring a certain child to participate in certain clubs 7 and activities in a certain manner; authorizing certain public high schools to assess 8 a certain child to determine whether the child meets certain academic requirements; 9 requiring a certain public high school to use a certain assessment when assessing a child under this Act; authorizing the State Department of Education to adopt certain 10 11 regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to children exempt from 12 public school attendance in the State.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 3 INDICATED.
- 4 (2) "ACTIVITIES" INCLUDES INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS.
- 5 (3) "ASSESSMENT" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 7–203.3 OF THIS
- 6 TITLE.
- 7 (B) (1) BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2017, A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM
- 8 SHALL ALLOW A CHILD EXEMPT FROM MANDATORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IN
- 9 ACCORDANCE WITH § 7-301 OF THIS TITLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 10 EXTRACURRICULAR CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE
- 11 SCHOOL SYSTEM.
- 12 (2) A CHILD WHO PARTICIPATES IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR
- 13 ACTIVITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:
- 14 (I) PARTICIPATE WITH THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL TO WHICH
- 15 THE CHILD WOULD BE ASSIGNED IF THE CHILD WERE TO ATTEND A PUBLIC HIGH
- 16 SCHOOL IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM;
- 17 (II) MEET THE SAME ELIGIBILITY OR TRYOUT CRITERIA FOR
- 18 PARTICIPATION IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY AS A STUDENT WHO
- 19 ATTENDS THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL;
- 20 (III) MEET EQUIVALENT ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR
- 21 PARTICIPATION IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY AS A STUDENT WHO
- 22 ATTENDS THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL;
- 23 (IV) COMPLY WITH THE SAME RESPONSIBILITIES AND
- 24 STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE AND BEHAVIOR, INCLUDING PRACTICI
- 25 REQUIREMENTS, THAT ARE REQUIRED OF A STUDENT WHO ATTENDS THE PUBLIC
- 26 HIGH SCHOOL AND PARTICIPATES IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY;
- 27 (V) PAY ANY OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE
- 28 PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL AS A RESULT OF THE CHILD'S INVOLVEMENT IN THE
- 29 EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY; AND
- 30 (VI) ON OR BEFORE THE THIRD DAY OF THE SEMESTER IN WHICH
- 31 THE CHILD INTENDS TO PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY:

- 1 NOTIFY THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL THAT THE CHILD 2 INTENDS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY; AND
- 3 **2.** COMPLETE ANY ASSOCIATED REGISTRATION 4 INFORMATION.
- 5 (C) (1) A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL MAY ASSESS A CHILD WHO INTENDS TO
 6 PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH
 7 THIS SECTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE CHILD MEETS THE ACADEMIC
 8 REQUIREMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2)(III) OF THIS SECTION.
- 9 (2) A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL THAT ASSESSES A CHILD UNDER THIS
 10 SUBSECTION SHALL USE THE SAME ASSESSMENTS THAT IT USES FOR ASSESSING A
 11 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT'S ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE
 12 EXTRACURRICULAR CLUB OR ACTIVITY.
- 13 **(D)** THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 14 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

- 16 (a) (1) In this section, "assessment" means a locally, State, or federally 17 mandated test that is intended to measure a student's academic readiness, learning 18 progress, and skill acquisition.
- 19 (2) "Assessment" does not include a teacher-developed quiz or test.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
