- 1 (2) AT THE REQUEST OF THE EMPLOYER, PROVIDES MANDATORY 2 ESSENTIAL SERVICES FOR THE SAFETY, CARE, AND WELFARE OF THE PEOPLE

- 4 (I) THE GOVERNOR; OR
- 5 (II) THE MAYOR, EXECUTIVE, OR GOVERNING BODY OF A 6 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- 7 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS A COVERED EMPLOYEE WHILE TRAVELING TO AND 8 FROM THE PERFORMANCE OF MANDATORY ESSENTIAL SERVICES DURING AN 9 EMERGENCY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2017.
