20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 AT LEAST 3 MONTHS BEFORE SUBMITTING A LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL TO THE 3 COUNTY DELEGATION FOR INTRODUCTION AS A BILL IN A SESSION OF THE 4 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE BOARD SHALL:

- 5 (1) POST A NOTICE OF THE PROPOSAL ON THE BOARD'S WEB SITE;
- 6 (2) SEND A NOTICE OF THE PROPOSAL BY E-MAIL TO EACH LICENSE 7 HOLDER; AND
- 8 (3) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSAL.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2017.
