1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Workgroup on Transportation for Middle and High School Students in Prince**
3 **George’s County**

4 **PG 415–17**

5 FOR the purpose of establishing the Workgroup on Transportation for Middle and High
6 School Students in Prince George’s County; providing for the composition and
7 staffing of the Workgroup; prohibiting a member of the Workgroup from receiving
8 certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses;
9 requiring the Workgroup to study and make recommendations regarding certain
10 matters; requiring the Workgroup to report its findings and recommendations to the
11 Prince George’s County House Delegation and the Prince George’s County Senators
12 on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally
13 relating to the Workgroup on Transportation for Middle and High School Students
14 in Prince George’s County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That:

3 (a) There is a Workgroup on Transportation for Middle and High School Students
4 in Prince George's County.

5 (b) The Workgroup consists of the following members:

6 (1) the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works
7 and Transportation, or the Director's designee or designees;

8 (2) the Chief Executive Officer of the Prince George's County Public
9 Schools, or the Chief Executive Officer's designee or designees; ~~and~~

10 (3) the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer of the Washington
11 Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, or the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer's
12 designee or designees;

13 (4) one representative of AFSCME Local 2250, selected by the President of
14 AFSCME Local 2250;

15 (5) one representative of AFSCME Local 2467, selected by the President of
16 AFSCME Local 2467; and

17 (6) one representative of the local union that represents the Washington
18 Metropolitan Area Transit Authority bus drivers, selected by the President of the local union.

19 (c) The Prince George's County Public Schools shall provide staff for the
20 Workgroup.

21 (d) A member of the Workgroup:

22 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Workgroup; but

23 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State
24 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

25 (e) The Workgroup shall:

26 (1) identify where Prince George's County public school buildings and bus
27 routes intersect with bus routes of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works
28 and Transportation and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority;

29 (2) identify the software systems currently in use by or available to the
30 Prince George's County Public Schools, the Prince George's County Department of Public

1 Works and Transportation, and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority to
2 operate and monitor their bus systems;

3 (3) estimate, if Prince George’s County Public Schools students were to be
4 transported by the Prince George’s County Department of Public Works and
5 Transportation and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, the:

6 (i) cost savings to the Prince George’s County Public Schools; and

7 (ii) cost increase to the Prince George’s County Department of Public
8 Works and Transportation and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority;

9 (4) determine the feasibility and cost of implementing a system utilizing
10 Global Positioning System technology and text messages to inform parents of when a bus
11 is expected to arrive and provide notification if a bus will be delayed; and

12 (5) identify a range of options for transporting Prince George’s County
13 Public Schools middle and high school students and the cost of each option.

14 (f) On or before August 31, 2017, the Workgroup shall report its findings and
15 recommendations to the Prince George’s County House Delegation and the Prince George’s
16 County Senators in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
18 1, 2017. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June
19 30, 2018, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
20 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
