A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

State Government - Creation and Maintenance of Religious Registry Prohibitions and Immunity for Refusal to Provide Information

4 FOR the purpose of providing that an official of State government, local government, or a $\mathbf{5}$ municipality is immune from certain liability for refusing to provide information to 6 the federal government or another state that will be used for the creation or 7 maintenance of a registry of individuals who belong to a specific religion or who hold 8 specific religious beliefs; authorizing the State to indemnify a certain official for certain costs and judgments; prohibiting an officer or unit of State government from 9 spending money from an appropriation to create or maintain a certain registry or to 1011 provide information to the federal government or another state that will be used in the creation or maintenance of a certain registry; prohibiting the State from 1213 reimbursing any expenditure to the extent that the expenditure violates a certain provision of this Act; providing that the State is not obligated to appropriate money 14 15to pay an expenditure that violates a certain provision of this Act; providing that 16each employee or member of a unit and each officer of the State government who 17makes a certain expenditure is guilty of neglect of official duty and is subject to 18 removal; prohibiting a person that receives State funds from using the State funds 19to create or maintain a certain registry or to provide information to the federal 20government or another state that will be used in the creation or maintenance of a 21certain registry; and generally relating to prohibited activities and immunity for a 22refusal to provide information related to the creation and maintenance of a religious 23registry.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

9 (A) AN OFFICIAL OF STATE GOVERNMENT, LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR A 10 MUNICIPALITY IS IMMUNE FROM CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LIABILITY FOR REFUSING TO 11 PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR ANOTHER STATE THAT 12 WILL BE USED FOR THE CREATION OR MAINTENANCE OF A REGISTRY OF 13 INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD SPECIFIC 14 RELIGIOUS BELIEFS.

15 (B) THE STATE MAY INDEMNIFY AN OFFICIAL OF STATE GOVERNMENT, 16 LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR A MUNICIPALITY FOR ANY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH OR 17 ANY JUDGMENT IN AN ACTION OR SUIT FILED BASED ON THE OFFICIAL'S REFUSING 18 TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR ANOTHER STATE 19 THAT WILL BE USED FOR THE CREATION OR MAINTENANCE OF A REGISTRY OF 20 INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD SPECIFIC 21 RELIGIOUS BELIEFS.

24 (A) AN OFFICER OR UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT MAY NOT SPEND MONEY 25 FROM AN APPROPRIATION TO:

26(1)CREATE OR MAINTAIN A REGISTRY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG27TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD SPECIFIC RELIGIOUS BELIEFS; OR

(2) PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR
 ANOTHER STATE THAT WILL BE USED IN THE CREATION OR MAINTENANCE OF A
 REGISTRY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD
 SPECIFIC RELIGIOUS BELIEFS.

32 (B) (1) THE STATE MAY NOT REIMBURSE ANY EXPENDITURE TO THE 33 EXTENT THAT THE EXPENDITURE VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

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1(2)THE STATE IS NOT OBLIGATED TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY2AN EXPENDITURE THAT VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

3 (C) EACH EMPLOYEE OR MEMBER OF A UNIT AND EACH OFFICER OF THE 4 STATE GOVERNMENT WHO MAKES AN EXPENDITURE THAT VIOLATES SUBSECTION 5 (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF NEGLECT OF OFFICIAL DUTY AND IS SUBJECT TO 6 REMOVAL.

7 **7-407.**

8 A PERSON THAT RECEIVES STATE FUNDS MAY NOT USE THE STATE FUNDS TO:

9 (1) CREATE OR MAINTAIN A REGISTRY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG 10 TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD SPECIFIC RELIGIOUS BELIEFS; OR

11 (2) PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR 12 ANOTHER STATE THAT WILL BE USED IN THE CREATION OR MAINTENANCE OF A 13 REGISTRY OF INDIVIDUALS WHO BELONG TO A SPECIFIC RELIGION OR WHO HOLD 14 SPECIFIC RELIGIOUS BELIEFS.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June1, 2017.
