SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19Article Transportation
 - 20 26–301.

21 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, any State agency authorized by law 22 and any political subdivision of this State may adopt ordinances or regulations that:

- (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;

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1 (2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of the 2 ordinances or regulations;

3 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately 4 owned parking lots; and

5 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an 6 ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.

7 (c) A political subdivision may not adopt or enforce an ordinance or regulation 8 that [prohibits]:

9 (1) **PROHIBITS** the parking of more than one motorcycle within a space 10 served by a single parking meter; **OR**

11 (2) INCREASES A PENALTY, AUTHORIZES REFERRAL FOR 12 COLLECTION, OR ASSESSES A FEE OR LATE CHARGE FOR AN UNPAID CITATION 13 ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION WITHIN **30** DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE 14 CITATION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2017.

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
