1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Local Plumbing Code – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law related to the adoption of a
4 plumbing code in St. Mary's County; and generally relating to the repeal of a
5 provision of law that relates to the adoption of a plumbing code in St. Mary's County.

6 BY repealing

7 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County

8 Section 92–1 and the chapter “Chapter 92. Plumbing Code”

9 Article 19 – Public Local Laws of Maryland

10 (2007 Edition and March 2015 Supplement, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 19 – St. Mary's County**

14 **[Chapter 92. Plumbing Code]**

15 **[92–1.**

16 A. The County Commissioners of St. Mary's County have the power to adopt,
17 amend and repeal rules and regulations pertaining to a County Plumbing Code.

1 B. In the administration of the Plumbing Code, state standards shall be utilized
2 as minimum requirements.

3 C. The County Commissioners of St. Mary’s County shall appoint a Plumbing
4 Board and budget funds for reasonable expenses incurred by Board members.]

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2017.
