## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Beer and Wine Licenses – Barbershops**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing in Frederick County a barbershop beer and wine license;  
4 requiring a recipient of the license to be a holder of a barbershop permit; authorizing  
5 a holder of the license to provide beer and wine by the glass for consumption by a  
6 certain customer when a certain service is provided or a certain fund–raising event  
7 is held; prohibiting the license from being transferred to another location; specifying  
8 the hours that the license privilege may be exercised; specifying an annual license  
9 fee; providing that an establishment for which the license is issued is subject to  
10 certain alcohol awareness training requirements; and generally relating to alcoholic  
11 beverages licenses in Frederick County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 20–102.

5 This title applies only in Frederick County.

6 **20–1001.2.**

7 **(A) THERE IS A BARBERSHOP BEER AND WINE LICENSE.**

8 **(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A HOLDER OF A BARBERSHOP**  
9 **PERMIT UNDER § 4–501 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS**  
10 **ARTICLE.**

11 **(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO PROVIDE NO MORE**  
12 **THAN 5 OUNCES OF BEER OR WINE BY THE GLASS FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION**  
13 **BY A BARBERSHOP CUSTOMER:**

14 **(1) WHEN THE CUSTOMER IS PROVIDED A SERVICE DESCRIBED IN §**  
15 **4–101(L) OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE; OR**

16 **(2) WHILE THE CUSTOMER IS ATTENDING A FUND–RAISING EVENT AT**  
17 **THE BARBERSHOP FOR WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS,**  
18 **IF REQUIRED, HAS ISSUED A PERMIT.**

19 **(D) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION.**

20 **(E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY PROVIDE BEER AND WINE FOR**  
21 **ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS BUT NOT LATER**  
22 **THAN 9 P.M.**

23 **(F) THE ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH A BARBERSHOP LICENSE IS ISSUED IS**  
24 **SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505**  
25 **OF THIS ARTICLE, SUBJECT TO § 20–1903 OF THIS TITLE.**

26 **(G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$100.**

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
28 1, 2017.
