- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Tax Property
- 16 9–211.
- 17 The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or
- 18 of a municipal corporation may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section
- 19 against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on residential real
- 20 property that the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the appropriate governing
- 21 body determines has suffered [flood damage or sewage] damage caused by [flood
- 22 conditions A NATURAL DISASTER.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
- 24 1, 2017, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2017.
