BY adding to Article – Environment Section 9–258 Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Environment 9-258.(A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS **(1)** INDICATED.
