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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Disposition of Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to approve and remit to the Anne Arundel  
4 County Board of License Commissioners, instead of to Anne Arundel County, certain  
5 amounts necessary to pay certain salaries, benefits, and expenses of the Board; and  
6 generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 11–102.

21 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

22 11–207.

23 From the fees received, the Comptroller shall:

1           (1)     approve and remit to the [county] **BOARD** the amounts necessary to  
2 pay the salaries and benefits of the Board and its employees;

3           (2)     approve and remit to the [county] **BOARD** the amount necessary to pay  
4 the expenses of the Board; and

5           (3)     at the end of each fiscal year, remit the balance of the fees received to  
6 the county for the general purposes of the county.

8           The Board shall:

9           (1)     collect all license fees required under this article;

10          (2)     issue all licenses in the county; and

11          (3)     remit all fees collected to the Comptroller.

12           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
13 1, 2017.
