written testimony on the General Assembly Web site within a certain time period
and link certain written testimony to a certain bill or resolution; and generally
relating to written testimony submitted to standing committees of the General
Assembly.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

19 **2–1106.**

BEFORE A BILL OR RESOLUTION IS REPORTED TO THE FLOOR BY A STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE STANDING COMMITTEE SHALL DELIVER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES ANY WRITTEN TESTIMONY RELATED TO THE BILL OR RESOLUTION THAT WAS SUBMITTED TO THE STANDING COMMITTEE.

2 (A) WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER A VOTING SESSION IN A STANDING COMMITTEE 3 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON A BILL OR RESOLUTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 4 PUBLISH ON THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WEB SITE ANY WRITTEN TESTIMONY 5 RELATED TO THE BILL OR RESOLUTION THAT IS SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT 6 UNDER § 2–1106 OF THIS TITLE.

7 (B) FOR ANY WRITTEN TESTIMONY PUBLISHED ON THE GENERAL 8 ASSEMBLY WEB SITE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE 9 DEPARTMENT SHALL LINK THE WRITTEN TESTIMONY TO THE RELATED BILL OR 10 RESOLUTION.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2017.
