- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article 19 – St. Mary's County

- 17 C. The Commission shall elect one (1) of its members as Chairman and one (1) of
- 18 its members as Vice Chairman, who shall serve in the absence or disability of the
- 19 Chairman. The Commission shall appoint, discharge at pleasure and fix the compensation
- 20 of a Director, a Secretary, [a Treasurer, a Chief Engineer] and engineering, legal, clerical
- 21 and other personnel and help which the Commission deems necessary to carry out the
- 22 provisions of this chapter. The Commission may, BY CONTRACT, appoint, discharge at
- 23 pleasure and fix the compensation of a General Counsel, TREASURER OR CHIEF
- 24 FINANCIAL OFFICER, CHIEF ENGINEER, AND ANY OTHER DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR.
- 25 The Director may not serve concurrently as the Director and as General Counsel to the

- 1 Commission. The Director shall be the immediate supervisor of the
- 2 GENERAL COUNSEL, TREASURER OR CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER, CHIEF
- 3 ENGINEER, AND ANY OTHER DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 2017.
