2 **State Lottery Tickets – Internet Sales – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency from
4 allowing a person to purchase a State lottery ticket through an electronic device that
5 connects to the Internet; and generally relating to the sale of State lottery tickets.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 INTERNET, SUCH AS A PERSONAL COMPUTER OR MOBILE DEVICE.

7 October 1, 2017.
