1 AN ACT concerning

Consumer Protection – Scanning Identification Cards and Driver's Licenses – Prohibition

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using a machine to scan an identification
card or a driver's license; prohibiting a person from retaining any information
collected from scanning an identification card or a driver's license or the barcode on
the identification card or driver's license; making a violation of this Act an unfair or
deceptive trade practice under the Maryland Consumer Protection Act and subject
to certain enforcement and penalty provisions; providing for the application of this
Act; and generally relating to scanning identification cards and driver's licenses.
