14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.

- 8 2. A video lottery facility located in Allegany County or 9 Worcester County may apply to the Commission for permission to assume ownership or the 10 right to lease each video lottery terminal device used by the facility.
