### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## **Transportation – Ignition Interlock Devices – Definition**

- FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "ignition interlock system" to require that an
  ignition interlock device be equipped with a camera capable of recording the image
  of the driver of the motor vehicle in which the device is installed; providing for the
  effective date of this Act; and generally relating to ignition interlock devices.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Transportation
  20 27–107.
  21 (a) In this section, "ignition interlock system" means a device that:
  22 (1) Connects a motor vehicle ignition system to a breath analyzer that measures a driver's blood alcohol level; [and]

1 (2)Prevents a motor vehicle ignition from starting if a driver's blood  $\mathbf{2}$ alcohol level exceeds the calibrated setting on the device; AND 3 (3) HAS A CAMERA CAPABLE OF RECORDING THE IMAGE OF THE 4 DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IN WHICH THE DEVICE IS INSTALLED.  $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 6 as follows: 7**Article – Transportation** 8 21 - 902.2. In this section, "ignition interlock system" means a device that: 9 (a) 10Connects a motor vehicle ignition system to a breath analyzer that (1)11 measures a driver's blood alcohol level; [and] (2)Prevents a motor vehicle ignition from starting if a driver's blood alcohol level exceeds the calibrated setting on the device; AND (3) 14HAS A CAMERA CAPABLE OF RECORDING THE IMAGE OF THE DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IN WHICH THE DEVICE IS INSTALLED. SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, if Section 2 of this Act takes 17effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take 18 effect October 1, 2017, the effective date of Chapter \_\_\_\_ (S.B. 165) of the Acts of the General 19 20Assembly of 2017. If the effective date of Chapter (S.B. 165) is amended, Section 2 of

21this Act shall take effect on the taking effect of Chapter (S.B. 165). If Chapter (S.B. 22165) does not take effect, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and 23effect.

24SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of 25Sections 3 and 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
