1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Highway Dedication – Senator Norman R. Stone, Jr. Highway**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to dedicate a certain
4 portion of highway in Baltimore County as the Senator Norman R. Stone, Jr.
5 Highway; and generally relating to highway dedications.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 **8–659.**

15 **THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEDICATE THE PORTION OF MARYLAND ROUTE**
16 **151 THAT IS LOCATED BETWEEN COVE ROAD AND BETHLEHEM BOULEVARD IN**
17 **BALTIMORE COUNTY AS THE SENATOR NORMAN R. STONE, JR. HIGHWAY.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
