- 7 (3) FOR A CONTRACEPTIVE DISPENSED ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 8 2018, DOES NOT EXCEED A 6-MONTH SUPPLY OF THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2017.
