1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission – Recording and Distribution During Legislative Session – Funding

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, each fiscal year, that the Governor include in the annual budget bill an appropriation to the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission to be $\mathbf{5}$ 6 used for certain purposes; providing for the calculation of the appropriation; 7 requiring the total appropriation in the annual budget bill to be altered by a certain 8 percentage each year; requiring the Commission, subject to a certain appropriation, 9 to record and distribute certain events or activities; requiring, if certain federal funds are reduced in a fiscal year, the Governor to include a certain appropriation in the 10 next fiscal year; stating the intent of the General Assembly; and generally relating 11 to an annual appropriation to the Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission. 12

27 (D) SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION UNDER § 24–204(D) OF THIS
 28 SUBTITLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL RECORD, ARCHIVE, AND DISTRIBUTE,

30 (1) THE ANNUAL STATE OF THE STATE ADDRESS;

31(2)FLOOR SESSIONS DURING THE LAST 2 WEEKS OF THE32LEGISLATIVE SESSION; AND

33 (3) THE STATE OF THE JUDICIARY ADDRESS.

1 <u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General</u> 2 <u>Assembly that, in the interest of transparency and unbiased reporting, the Governor</u> 3 <u>include in the annual budget an appropriation of at least \$500,000 to the Maryland Public</u> 4 <u>Broadcasting Commission to record, archive, distribute, and stream:</u>

- 5 <u>(1)</u> the annual State of the State Address;
 - (2) floor sessions during the last 2 weeks of the legislative session; and
- 7 (3) the State of the Judiciary Address.

8 SECTION 2. <u>3.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 June 1, 2017.
