17 (A) In this subtitle[, "veteran-owned] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 18 MEANINGS INDICATED.

19 (B) "SMALL BUSINESS" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 14–501 OF THIS 20 TITLE.

(C) "VETERAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVED ON ACTIVE DUTY IN
 THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, OTHER THAN FOR TRAINING, AND WAS
 DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE.



1 (D) "VETERAN-OWNED small business enterprise" means a SMALL business 2 that is [verified by the Center for Veterans Enterprise of the United States Department of 3 Veterans Affairs as a veteran-owned small business] AT LEAST 51% OWNED BY ONE OR 4 MORE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE VETERANS.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2017.
