A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Registration – Exception for Municipal RTV Utility Vehicles – Town of**
3 **Sykesville**

4 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements
5 under certain circumstances for municipal RTV utility vehicles on local highways in
6 the Town of Sykesville, Carroll County; providing that a person who operates a
7 municipal RTV utility vehicle on a local highway in the Town of Sykesville, Carroll
8 County, may operate the municipal RTV utility vehicle only on certain local roads at
9 certain times and only if the municipal RTV utility vehicle is equipped with certain
10 lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a municipal RTV utility vehicle on
11 a local highway in the Town of Sykesville to keep as far to the right of the roadway
12 as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the Carroll County
13 Department of Public Works, in consultation with the State Highway
14 Administration, to designate the local highways in the Town of Sykesville on which
15 a person may operate a municipal RTV utility vehicle; and generally relating to an
16 exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for municipal RTV utility
17 vehicles in the Town of Sykesville, Carroll County.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article – Transportation**

8 13–402.

9 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the
10 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on
11 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.

12 (c) Registration under this subtitle is not required for:

13 (1) A vehicle that is driven on a highway:

14 (i) In conformity with the provisions of this title relating to
15 manufacturers, transporters, dealers, secured parties, owners or operators of special mobile
16 equipment, or nonresidents; or

17 (ii) Under a temporary registration card issued by the
18 Administration;

19 (2) A vehicle owned and used by the United States, unless an authorized
20 officer or employee of the United States requests registration of the vehicle;

21 (3) A farm tractor or any farm equipment;

22 (4) A vehicle the front or rear wheels of which are lifted from the highway;

23 (5) A towed vehicle that is attached to the towing vehicle by a tow bar and
24 for which no driver is necessary;

25 (6) A vehicle owned by and in the possession of a licensed dealer for purpose
26 of sale;

27 (7) A vehicle owned by a new resident of this State during the first 60 days
28 of residency provided the vehicle displays valid registration issued by the jurisdiction of the
29 resident's former domicile;

30 (8) New vehicles being operated as part of a shuttle, as defined in § 13–626
31 of this title, while following a registered vehicle displaying a shuttle permit issued by the
32 Administration;

1 (9) A vehicle operated in connection with maritime commerce exclusively
2 within any terminal owned or leased by the Maryland Port Administration;

3 (10) A snowmobile that is operated on highways and roadways as prescribed
4 by § 25–102(a)(14) of this article;

5 (11) A golf cart that is operated on a highway on Smith Island, provided that
6 the golf cart is equipped with lighting devices as required by the Administration if it is
7 operated on a highway between dusk and dawn;

8 (12) A golf cart that is operated on a highway in the City of Crisfield,
9 Somerset County, in accordance with § 21–104.2 of this article;

10 (13) **A MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE THAT IS OPERATED ON A
11 LOCAL HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF SYKESVILLE, CARROLL COUNTY, IN
12 ACCORDANCE WITH § 21–104.3 OF THIS ARTICLE;**

13 (14) A golf cart that is operated on an Allegany County highway as allowed
14 by the county under § 25–102(a)(16) of this article; or

15 [(14)] (15) A vehicle owned by an accredited consular or diplomatic officer
16 of a foreign government and operated for official or personal purposes when the vehicle
17 displays a valid diplomatic license plate issued by the United States government.

19 (A) **A PERSON WHO OPERATES A MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE ON A
20 LOCAL HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF SYKESVILLE, CARROLL COUNTY, WITHOUT
21 REGISTRATION AS AUTHORIZED UNDER § 13–402(C)(13) OF THIS ARTICLE:**

22 (1) **MAY OPERATE THE MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE ONLY:**

23 (I) **ON A LOCAL HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE MAXIMUM POSTED
24 SPEED LIMIT DOES NOT EXCEED 35 MILES PER HOUR;**

25 (II) **BETWEEN DAWN AND DUSK; AND**

26 (III) **IF THE MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED
27 WITH LIGHTING DEVICES AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION;**

28 (2) **SHALL KEEP THE MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE AS FAR TO
29 THE RIGHT OF THE ROADWAY AS FEASIBLE; AND**

30 (3) **SHALL POSSESS A VALID DRIVER’S LICENSE.**

1 **(B) THE CARROLL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN**
2 **CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, MAY DESIGNATE THE**
3 **LOCAL HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF SYKESVILLE ON WHICH A PERSON MAY OPERATE**
4 **A MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2017.
