## Vehicle Registration – Exception for Municipal RTV Utility Vehicles – Town of Sykesville

- FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements 4 5 under certain circumstances for municipal RTV utility vehicles on local highways in 6 the Town of Sykesville, Carroll County; providing that a person who operates a 7 municipal RTV utility vehicle on a local highway in the Town of Sykesville, Carroll 8 County, may operate the municipal RTV utility vehicle only on certain local roads at 9 certain times and only if the municipal RTV utility vehicle is equipped with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a municipal RTV utility vehicle on 10 11 a local highway in the Town of Sykesville to keep as far to the right of the roadway 12 as feasible and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the Carroll County 13 Department of Public Works, in consultation with the State Highway Administration, to designate the local highways in the Town of Sykesville on which 14 a person may operate a municipal RTV utility vehicle; and generally relating to an 15 16 exception to motor vehicle registration requirements for municipal RTV utility 17 vehicles in the Town of Sykesville, Carroll County.

- 1 (B) THE CARROLL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION, MAY DESIGNATE THE LOCAL HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF SYKESVILLE ON WHICH A PERSON MAY OPERATE A MUNICIPAL RTV UTILITY VEHICLE.
