A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Ocean City Convention Center - Beer and Wine Tasting License

FOR the purpose of establishing in Worcester County a 1-day beer and wine tasting license; 4 $\mathbf{5}$ authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue a license to an organization 6 representing local governments in the State for a certain purpose; prohibiting the 7 Board from issuing more than a certain number of licenses per year; providing that 8 an organization may apply for not more than one license per year; authorizing the 9 holder of a license to allow the on-premises consumption, for tasting, of beer or wine 10 on the premises of the Ocean City Convention Center under certain circumstances; 11 providing that the license holder may serve beer and wine only in certain quantities 12for each offering; requiring that a certain individual who serves beer and wine have 13 a certificate of completion of a certain alcohol awareness program; requiring an 14 organization to apply for a license at least a certain time before the license is issued; 15setting the fee for a license; and generally relating to a beer and wine tasting license 16in Worcester County.
