10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
<p>The Marlton Swim and Recreation Club, Inc. exists to provide the community with a safe, enjoyable place to swim, receive swimming instruction, get fit, enjoy outdoor recreation, and relax with family and other members of the community. It is in a residential neighborhood and consists of several wooded acres, an outdoor 25-meter length pool with diving area and wading pool. Activities include swimming lessons, water safety instruction, aqua fitness classes, programs for scouts and youth, recreation for local summer camps and daycare, swim team (along with hosting swim meets), "family night" socials, and availability for groups to rent for birthday parties and reunions.</p>					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Funds will be used for repairs and fixture replacement in the restroom/shower areas to include toilets, urinals, sinks, showers and plumbing. One toilet stall and shower stall in each restroom would be made suitable for handicapped use. One diaper changing station in each bathroom will be installed. Security entry doors and one window will be replaced in addition to installing a dutch door into the office area that functions as a customer service area. Natural gas lines leading to the hot water heater will be replaced, along with the hot water heater. The 300-hundred gallon back wash tanks will be replaced to support efficiency of the filter system. The concrete walkway around bathhouse will be replaced. Portions of the main and wading pools will be recaulked. A permanent shade fixture near the wading pool will be installed. Wooden columns supporting portico roof will be repaired. Painting and concrete floor repair as required.
