A not for profit 501 (c)(3) charity, the YMCA of the Chesapeake's mission is to foster opportunities for individuals, families, and community that strengthen healthy spirit, mind and body for all. At the Y, strengthening community is our cause. Every day, the Y works side by side with our neighbors to ensure that everyone, regardless of age, income or background, has the opportunity to learn, grow and thrive.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

In May 2007, the YMCA opened a wellness center in a store front location to begin serving the health and wellness needs of the community. Programs continue to focus on helping people of all backgrounds and abilities to grow in spirit, mind and body. Over the past six years, the St. Michaels Family YMCA has grown from 600 members to over 1,900 serving almost half the population of St. Michaels and the Bay Hundred area. While the St. Michaels Family YMCA reaches nearly half of the population of St. Michaels and the Bay Hundred area, the current facility is not adequate to meet the growing needs of the community. The YMCA plans to build a 24,000 square foot facility on school property located next to St. Michaels High School. The new facility will provide additional resources and opportunities for local not-for-profit organizations, and churches to work together to meet the needs of the St. Michaels and Bay Hundred community.
