<b>10. Description and Purpose of Organization</b> (Limit length to visible area)							

The mission of the Boys & Girls Club of Westminster is To inspire and enable all young people, to realize their full potential as productive, responsible and caring citizens. We accomplish this by providing a safe place to learn and grow, develop ongoing relationships with caring adult professionals, participate in life-enhancing programs, build character development experiences, hope, and opportunity. In all of our programs we utilize a time-tested youth development strategy. BGCW serves 120 young people ages 6-18 daily with the support adult and high school volunteers. Our population ethnicity/gender: 27% African American; 2% Asian; 40% Caucasian; 14% Hispanic/Latino; 17% Multi-Racial; 53% Males and 47% Females. Household Demographics: 75% Single Parent Homes; 72% Free/Reduced Lunch; 83% of our families are at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

BGCW's new site will house a larger Boys & Girls Club which can serve 600 kids annually. The site will add a dedicated teen program, and expanded enrichment and leadership opportunities for Carroll County youth. BGCW, a 501 (c) (3) non-profit, is the only Boys & Girls Club in Carroll County, serving kids ages 6-18 with after-school and summer programs. The Club has reached capacity in its current 2,500 sq. ft. facility and now has a waiting list of 68 children. BGCW will renovate a 14,000 sq. ft. building. Phase 1 of the project includes repair of interior and exterior walls, installation of safety glass, interior painting, new ADA compliant entrances, new roof, relocation and update of electrical system, new HVAC, new curb and sidewalk, new fire protection/sprinkler system, renovation and expansion of restrooms, and new carpeting/flooring. Phase 2 of the project includes constructing a gym onto the back of the existing building that will add 7,000 sq. ft.
