This bill repeals provisions of local law regarding the licensing and regulation of hucksters, hawkers, and peddlers selling fruits or vegetables in Carroll County.

**Current Law:** Title 6 of the Public Local Laws of Carroll County provides for the licensing and regulation of hucksters, hawkers, and peddlers in Carroll County. Provisions include (1) what hucksters and peddlers may sell; (2) license fees; and (3) fines.
